SMARTCOAT™ 365 SILICONE REPAIR MASTIC

CAN BE APPLIED TO WET OR DRY SURFACES - UV RESISTANT

Product Information



Description & Use: SMARTCOAT™ 365 is a flashing grade, stand-alone, fiber-fortified silicone mastic for direct-bond permanent repairs to many roof surfaces including asphalt, single-ply, metal, and most existing coatings. Examples of use include but are not limited to punctures caused from hail damage or mechanically induced damage from foot traffic or HVAC servicing, fish mouths or surface cracks, roof details such as control joints, coping joints, and gutter seams. SMARTCOAT 365 can be utilized as an emergency repair solution in wet/under water conditions, see application notes for precautions. SMARTCOAT 365 is UV-stable; it does not require a top coat and will not chalk, crack, or peel if left exposed. When you want a repair that's more than a patch, SMARTCOAT 365 is your go-to.

Coverage: 24-26 sq. ft. per pail applied 1/8" thick; additional material may be required when 3-coursing to saturate and encapsulate polyester fabric.

Precautions: SMARTCOAT 365 requires atmospheric moisture for propagation of cure thus it is not suitable for use in totally confined spaces. Inclement weather may displace uncured SMARTCOAT 365; proceed with caution if heavy rain, hail or snowfall is impending or expected within 4 hours of application. For cold weather application, keep material stored above 65°F (18°C). Do not apply to substrates with temperatures below freezing.

SMARTCOAT 365 can be applied over properly prepared surfaces that exhibit ponded water, however, the National Roofing Contractors Association (NRCA) considers ponding water an undesirable nonstandard roofing practice and recommends that all roof systems be designed and built to ensure positive drainage. (See the NRCA Roofing and Waterproofing Manual).

Product Application

SMARTCOAT 365 should be applied as received and dilution with solvent is not recommended. SMARTCOAT 365 is engineered not to settle and should not require mixing. However, if settling in the package has occurred, stir the material prior to use.

- 1. When possible, clean roof surface thoroughly, using SMARTCOAT 100 ROOF WASH as needed. Surface must be free of dirt, dust, oil, grease, wax, rust, chalky or loose paint, mildew and any other surface contamination that may inhibit adhesion. SMARTCOAT 365 may be applied in wet conditions or under water but standing water shall be removed prior to application as possible.
- 2. When utilizing for new flashing details, if adhesion test indicates primer is required, prime surface with SMARTCOAT 210 Universal Primer. When applying on a smooth or granulated modified bitumen or built-up-roof, though most granulated surfaces do not require primer for adhesion, SMARTCOAT 200 Asphalt Bleed Blocker will serve to prevent top-surface yellowing from migrating bituminous oils.
- 3. Inspect all fasteners; replace loose, broken or missing ones.
- 4. Material shall be applied between 1/8"-1/4" thick with a brush, trowel or gloved hand and extend two inches on either side of the fastener or split. SMARTCOAT 365 is typically applied in one application. If applying in multiple applications, allow adequate time between each application for the mastic to cure before applying additional material. Details or repairs with a high potential for movement may require polyester reinforcement and/or the use of a sacrificial release tape. When reinforcing with polyester, thickness shall be sufficient to saturate and encapsulate polyester reinforcement. Refer to SMARTCOAT construction details for guidance. Tack free in 2 hours. Dry to touch in 6 hours. Drying time is dependent on temperature, humidity and film thickness. Final cured thicknesses must be free of voids, pinholes, cracks or blisters.
 - When applied in wet conditions or under water, additional pressure will be required to ensure an adequate bond. Once conditions are dry, inspect the repair. If water was entrapped, which will manifest as a bubble, or the seal is poor, remove and redo the repair.
- 5. If coating, allow MASTIC to dry approximately 6 hours, depending on temperature and humidity, prior to coating with SMARTCOAT 450 High Solids Silicone Coating. It is not intended to be painted or covered over with any product other than SMARTCOAT Silicone Roof Coatings.
- 6. Clean equipment containing uncured material may be accomplished by cleaning with mineral spirits, toluene, or alcohol based solvents. DO NOT USE water.

Storage, Transport & Disposal: Store in cool, dry conditions. Store locked up. SMARTCOAT 365 can be stored in unheated warehouses during the cooler months without the risk of freezing. Shelf life is 18 months from date of manufacture when properly stored. Be sure the lid is tight and the pail is secured when transporting this product. Do not allow pail to tumble as this may loosen the lid and allow leakage or spillage to occur.
